# A BILL

To reinstate year-round Federal Pell Grants under the Higher Education Act of 1965.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Access to Education  
5 and Training Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. FEDERAL PELL GRANTS.**

7 (a) AMENDMENTS.—Section 401(b) of the Higher  
8 Education Act of 1965 ((20 U.S.C. 1070a(b)) is amend-  
9 ed—

1           (1) in paragraph (2)(A)(ii), by striking “para-  
2           graph (7)(B)” and inserting “paragraph (8)(B)”

3           (2) by redesignating paragraphs (5) through  
4           (7) as paragraphs (6) through (8), respectively; and

5           (3) by inserting after paragraph (4) the fol-  
6           lowing:

7           “(5)(A) The Secretary shall award a student  
8           not more than two Federal Pell Grants during a sin-  
9           gle award year to permit such student to accelerate  
10          the student’s progress toward a degree or certificate  
11          if the student is enrolled—

12                 “(i) on at least a half-time basis for a pe-  
13                 riod of more than one academic year, or more  
14                 than two semesters or an equivalent period of  
15                 time, during a single award year; and

16                 “(ii) in a program of instruction at an in-  
17                 stitution of higher education for which the insti-  
18                 tution awards an associate or baccalaureate de-  
19                 gree or certificate.

20          “(B) In the case of a student receiving more  
21          than one Federal Pell Grant in a single award year  
22          under subparagraph (A), the total amount of Fed-  
23          eral Pell Grants awarded to such student for the  
24          award year may exceed the maximum basic grant

1 level specified in the appropriate appropriations Act  
2 for such award year.”.

3 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendments made by  
4 subsection (a) shall be effective for award year 2013-2014  
5 and each succeeding award year
